The role of the LGC is carefully defined with responsibility to monitor the quality of education through pupil outcomes and the school curriculum, safeguarding, attendance and the wellbeing of staff and pupils. The LGC act as a voice for pupils, staff and parents within the trust and make recommendations about what is best for the school and its pupils.

## TRUST OPERATIONS

It's important to us that we have specialists in every area of work so that schools are provided with excellent knowledge and advice in areas such as Finance & Budgeting, People Management & Payroll, Health & Safety, Governance & Compliance. In our model, schools contribute a percentage of their GAG funding to provide the core services. Schools in the trust "pool" their reserves and this ensures equity for everyone, across all schools, regardless of size or context and is part of our collaborative and nurturing shared values. The central team and individual schools can make requests for resources to fund school improvement activities, both education and capital, at specific times throughout the year.

The partnership contribution ensures that we can provide services which do the "heavy-lifting" so every leader can focus on school led activities. Having experts in their field of work, supports school leaders and governors to know that the decisions they make are compliant in important areas such as the health & safety regulations, employment law & financial regularities.
